It is investing \$23m to equip and operate the Centre, which will be ready by 2011, with state-of-the-art facilities such as:

- Advanced cancer screening using PET CT scan and other diagnostic equipment
- Multi-disciplinary cancer treatments including chemotherapy, surgical oncology and radiation oncology
- Latest available radiotherapy system
- 24-hour nursing facilities with extended cancer care services

Pacific Cancer Centre will also offer comprehensive and advanced health screening assessments. Located at 19 Adam Road, it is a short 10-minute drive to Pacific Healthcare's main specialist centres in Orchard Paragon, close to major private hospitals such as Gleneagles, Mt. Elizabeth and Mt Alvernia.

Aside from its central location and accessibility, the 3-storey cancer hospital will have extended high ceilings, lush green surroundings and spacious open courtyards. With an estimated floor area of 28,000 sq ft, it will include a 24-hour clinic, day surgery facility with operating theatres, chemotherapy suites and consultation rooms. The top floor will house 10 luxurious inpatient rooms fully equipped for chemotherapy as well as post-surgical recuperative care.

Dr Steven Tucker, eminent US cancer specialist leading the medical team, points out the need for a 24-hour cancer hospital: "Cancer patients have enough to deal with already. We aim to provide them the latest in care, without compromising on daily comforts."



Adds Dr William Chong, CEO of Pacific Healthcare: “Cancer is one of the leading causes of death worldwide and the numbers are projected to increase. With early detection, education, appropriate treatment and therapy, cancer can be contained and the quality of life improved.
