



Pacific Healthcare Opens 8th Women's Wellness Centre In China Shenzhen

- Centre in Shenzhen prime residential district fills niche in high-end women's beauty and lifestyle segment
- Expansion in line with Pacific Healthcare's core competencies

Singapore, 15 October 2007 – Main Board-listed Pacific Healthcare Holdings Ltd ("PHH" or 太平保健), a leading Singapore provider of integrated, multidisciplinary specialist healthcare services, announced the opening of its 8th women's wellness centre in Shenzhen through subsidiary Shen Zhen Marsa Pacific Chain Enterprise ("Marsa Pacific").

Located in the prime residential Nanshan district of Shenzhen, the luxurious wellness centre and spa occupies 6,000 sq ft and is within the scenic Swan Lake Club in HuaQiao Cheng. Marsa Pacific also plans to open a medical and dental clinic in Huaqiangbei Road, Futian District, Shenzhen by November 2007.

Dr William Chong (张来良), CEO of PHH said, "The growth of the Shenzhen economy has fuelled demand for cosmetic services and our new centre will fill a niche in the high-end women's beauty and lifestyle market segment. This corresponds with Pacific's core competences in the fields of women's healthcare and cosmetic medical and dental services."

He added, "We are excited about developments in China. Aside from these facilities in Shenzhen, we will also be officially opening our diagnostic centre in Shanghai on 22nd October, concurrently with the inauguration of the Shanghai Kanglian Hospital." On 8th May, Pacific Healthcare announced its acquisition of a 52.5% stake in Marsa Guer Chained Enterprise ("Marsa") from prominent local businesswoman, Ms Eva Au and her family.

Marsa currently has an existing database of 25,000 members and the new centre via Marsa Pacific will offer its elite group of members more exclusive and private beauty and spa services in a luxurious setting. These customers are expected to form the patient pool and springboard for its planned medical and dental clinic in Futian District. Marsa reported net after tax earnings of RMB 4.96 million (approximately SGD 1 million) in 2006.

PHH has, in recent months, stepped up its expansion overseas, particularly in China and India, the world's two fastest growing markets for private quality healthcare services. PHH holds a 51% stake in the diagnostic centre in Shanghai and an effective 10.5% share in the Shanghai Kanglian Hospital.
